



## HOW TO PLAY



The goal of the game is to test knowledge and strategic thinking through questions, answers, and betting. Players agree on a playing order and each starts with 10 chips provided by the bank. In each round, one player acts as the mediator, responsible for keeping time, acting as the bank, and reading the question from the first card in the deck.

After the question is read aloud, all players—including the mediator—have a set amount of time to write their answer. When time is up, all answers are revealed, and the betting phase begins. Each player places bets on the answer they believe is correct.

Once betting ends, the correct answer (on the back of the card) is revealed. If any of the responses on the table is sufficiently similar to the official answer, the players who bet on it win the chips that were wagered in that round. If more than one player bets on the correct answer, the chips are distributed according to the following rules.

The game ends when each player has served as mediator twice. The winner is the player with the most chips.

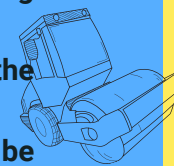

## RULES



- Players have 1 minute and 30 seconds to answer written questions and 2 minutes for calculation questions.
- The use of a calculator is allowed.
- Players may bet up to 2 chips per round.
- Players can only bet on one answer per round.
- No player may abstain from submitting an answer or from betting on the answer they consider correct.
- Once all responses are on the table, players may discuss the answers.
- If more than one identical answer is given, those cards must be stacked one on top of the other and treated as a single answer. The mediator for the round decides whether answers are considered equivalent.
- After the correct answer is revealed on the back of the card, players must agree on which answer on the table is correct, or whether none is correct. If there is no consensus, the mediator makes the final decision.
- The bank gives one chip to each player who wrote the correct answer. Thus, if all players provide the same correct answer, the bank must give one chip to each.
- If there are no correct answers, the bank collects all chips bet in that round.
- The player who bets on the correct answer wins the amount of chips bet on that answer for the round. If more than one player bets on the correct answer, the bank doubles the total bet and divides the chips equally among them.
- In the last round, players have the option to bet all of their remaining chips on a single answer.
